

## Lock Haven Catholic School PTO Meeting

### Opening Prayer

Principal's Report- Mrs. Alexander reported that the first marking period will be finishing up; report cards will go out the beginning of November. Faith Families started, and it is going well. The students are working hard. The Christmas Program is changing this year; a schedule will be coming out and supplies will be needed to be purchased from the PTO.

Treasurer's Report- A treasurer's report was made available by Misty Myers which included detailed information of the current PTO balance, fundraising profits from the different fundraising events to date, and the specific expenses and deposits.

School Council Report- Cathy Rizzo reported that the Fall Festival was very successful this year and about \$9,000 profit was made.

Box Tops Report- Keep collecting box tops! The next box tops collection week will be October 15<sup>th</sup>-19<sup>th</sup>; the class that collects the most will get a special treat. It was also discussed that the Parish Office will be contacted to see about adding box top collection to the Church Bulletin, so parishioners can turn them to benefit the school as well.

Playground Committee Report- Someone was found that is willing to do just the concrete work; \$1200-\$1300 in labor. When to start the project was discussed with a potential time of the second week of June (2019). Grants were also submitted, \$500 was received from the Catholic Foundation. A grant is currently pending with the Walmart Foundation (takes 90 days to process and was submitted on October 1<sup>st</sup>). The Community Foundation Grant is due December 15<sup>th</sup>; can apply for grant with American Dermatology Association, Kira will gather the necessary documents from faculty highlighting sun protection. \$700 is also possible to receive from the Target Field Trip Grant (this could cover the cost of the Millbrook Field Trip in the Spring).

### New Business

**Dues:** a form needs to go out in the next white envelope to remind families to submit their PTO dues (\$5 per family).

**Kellogg's Feeding Reading Program:** Molly will include information regarding this in the PTO newsletter.

**Family Bingo Night:** is scheduled for March 20, 2019.

**New idea(s):** Sarah proposed a possible family Karaoke Night; PTO can provide light refreshments. Possible date of February 8, 2018. Sarah will look into potential songs.
