Opening Prayer

Principal's Report- Mrs. Alexander- We're open!!! Water bottle fillers are on back order; UV cleaners at night on top of the extensive cleaning/sanitizing process during the day. There will be no more tickets for lunch, it will be done electronically; parents can send an email to Mrs. Sanders if they want to know their child's lunch money balance. For recess, grades only play with each other to try to eliminate any cross-over between classes.

Treasurer's Report- Misty Myers provided PTO with the current PTO balance with debits included for the start of the school year.

School Council Report- Majority of recap of COVID information that Mrs. Alexander already stated; Enrollment numbers are down 4 families this year. A possible online fundraiser is being discussed involving a basket type raffle/auction with donations already given for the Cash Bash that was cancelled.

New Business

Reviewed PTO pamphlet that was in the White envelope. There will be no dine around towns scheduled at this time and we do have a balanced budget for PTO.

Mums – We had a large amount of orders and 63 families participated in this fundraiser! We will need volunteers to help remove the mums from the trucks, once delivered. Also, will need help when parents pick up the orders. Pick-up time 1 – 8, Mrs. Alexander will send out an email with pick up times. They might need to use 3 trucks to deliver the order and cost per truck is \$25.00. They will be delivering at 10 am, per Mary that runs the greenhouse. With the order being this big, it will take several hours to set up.

Possible drive-through held at the church – Mazzie reported that there are about 6 dozen pizza shells, sauce, cheese, and pepperoni leftover from the church drive thru fundraiser events and the church is willing to donate those to PTO to complete a fundraiser utilizing the supplies and set up at the parish center. Mazzie discussed the amount of time left on the pizza shells in order to see when this event would need to take place. Ultimately it was decided due to the small amount of time to pull this event together, PTO chose to have the parish donate the pizzas to frontline workers and first responders. PTO can revisit a possible fundraiser utilizing the parish food trailers at a later date.

Other Info:

Playground – Awning will be going up in the next month. Quotes sent to Janine at AAD. They are including the installation of the electric to operate the awning as well and that was sent to her last week. It takes 4 weeks to receive the check. We should be receiving the sign in 2-3 weeks.
