We have a few different ways that you can be involved and hope that you will consider spending a part of your day with us. Who can help - parents, grandparents, guardians, etc. Where is help needed?

**Cafeteria** - Help children open lunch items, assist with cleaning the tables before the next lunch group arrives, inter-acting with the children as they eat. Help is needed from 11:00 AM - 12:00 PM.

**Playground** - Playing with the children, watch to make sure kids are safe. Help is needed from 11:25 AM to 12:25 PM.

**Room Parent** - Help the teacher as needed to organize special events in the classroom.

**Special Events** - Help with Field Day, Race for Education, TSA, etc.
