READING

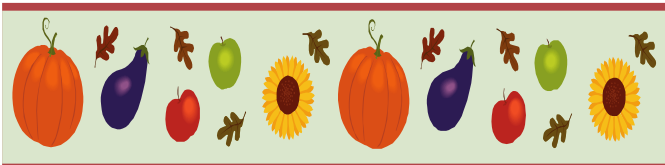

Math
